DAY 1 TO 5

This segment will provide basic information of Spanish language like sounds & alphabets, greetings & farewells. Afterwards, we would like to know about your likes and interest for Spanish language and then blend you in to get started. After this you'll be able to introduce yourself in Spanish. You will get to know the words used for professions & nationalities.

DAY 6 TO 10

This session will give Spanish words to describe your like & interests and also to talk about your hobbies. Then you will learn some basic information such as names of weekdays and months in Spanish. Clock will also play an important role in this session as you will be taught how to tell time in Spanish language in 12 & 24 hour clock.

DAY 11 TO 15

Starting from the topic of weather and climate, this lecture will teach you Spanish names for colors. Then you will learn different types of verbs, some difference between important verbs along with their rule of conjugation so that you can make the sentences easily.

DAY 16 TO 20

In this section you will study how to communicate in transit i.e., with airport and transportation staff while travelling and at your residence place. You will understand the vocabulary related to cuisines and beverages used in a restaurant. This lecture will also show how to follow map directions in Spanish and the basic vocabulary about health and emergencies will be provided in this section.

DAY 21 TO 25

In this segment, you will learn how to communicate with the local transportation to reach destination, asking directions & places with natives. Conversation for booking a hotel room, asking about activities and discussing plans. There will be classes related to different mode of traveling where we'll get to know how we can have conversation with airport staff.

DAY 25 TO 30

Here we will have conversations on different scenarios like visiting the historical sites & museum, discussing art of different styles, exploring new and interesting places, ordering food, asking for recommendations and discussing food preferences. We'll have an idea to develop yourself in situations like arriving at the airport, taking a taxi or bus and renting a car.

DAY 31 TO 35

In this period, you will be taught how to interact with locals at the beach, asking for recommendations and discussing favorite activities. Discussing art with gallery staff or visitors, asking about exhibitions and sharing opinions on artwork. Ordering food at a street food stall, asking for recommendations and discussing local cuisine.
